1) for participation (indicate in the file name, for example, *Application_Ivanova*)

2) abstracts that correspond to the topic of the conference, drawn up in accordance with the requirements; for students, it is also necessary to send a **review** (in the file name indicate, for example, *Abstracts_Ivanova*, *Review_Ivanova*), if the abstracts are co-authored with a supervisor, a review is not required

3) a copy or a screenshot of the receipt of payment of the organizational fee in the amount of UAH 250.

Single publications by doctors of sciences are free!

Requirements for abstracts:

Volume – 3-5 pages, editor – Microsoft Word; file with the extension *.doc, *.docx.

Standards: 14 pt font, line spacing -1.5; paragraph indentation -1.25 cm; margins on all sides -2 cm; font - Times New Roman.

Pages are not to be numbered, no word hyphenation.

The following symbols should be used in the text: quotation marks like $\ll \ldots \gg$, hyphen (-), dash (-), apostrophe (').

The author is responsible for the content of the material presented.

References in the text to sources should be indicated in parentheses (author's name, year, page), for example: (*Kyryliuk, 2018, p. 15*).

The structure of the publication:

First line: author's name and initials (bold, italics, right alignment). (Students also indicate the position and name of the supervisor, for example: Supervisor: Candidate of Pedagogical Sciences, Associate Professor Yarova L.O.).

The second line and further: academic degree, title, position, name of the educational institution, city, country (italics, right alignment).

One line later – the title of the publication (capital letters, bold, center alignment).

The text of the thesis should be single-spaced (width alignment).

After the text should be one-line indentation, and on a new line - LITERATURE (capital letters, bold, center alignment).

The list of references is in alphabetical order. The list of references should be drawn up in accordance with the international standard APA (7th ed.), without numbering the source in the list of references (examples of references are available at the link: https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples)

The conference materials will be published in a collection of abstracts with an assigned **ISBN** and published on the university's website. Conference participants will receive a **certificate** and a collection of abstracts in pdf format by e-mail.

Attention to scientists, doctoral students, and postgraduates!

If desired, the abstracts can be expanded into an article and published in the professional scientific journal "Scientific Notes. Series: Philological Sciences" (founder - Volodymyr Vynnychenko Central Ukrainian State University). The scientific journal is published periodically.
